1. Can you help me understand the Reference form? Do we send this form to the reference recipient? The turnaround time for the recipient is pretty tight? Can we also include the reference contact information in the bid?

2. Can you tell us how many units of each device the agency has active?

13 total.

- a. How many active SCRAM? How many active Remote Breath?

Right now we are utilizing 2 SCRAM bracelets and 11 Remote Breath devices.

3. SCRAM and Remote Breath are a manufacture specific name for devices, would the County be willing to refer to the devices as, Transdermal (scram), and portable breath testing (remote breath)?

That would be fine to refer to the devices as transdermal and portable breath test.

4. Will the County entertain an extension for the due date?

No extension to the due date will be granted.

5. For the County's electronic monitoring program and offender population that is currently being monitored, please provide the following information:

- a. The current provider of electronic monitoring equipment and services.

Rocky Mountain Offender Management Systems

- b. The average number of active SCRAM devices.

The average number is between 1 and 5 at a time.

- Please also provide the current daily rate the County is paying for *SCRAM* devices.

The County is paying \$10.00 per day.

c. The average number of active *SCRAMx* devices.

The average number is between 1 and 5 at a time.

- Please also provide the current daily rate the County is paying for *SCRAMx* devices.

The County is paying \$12.00 per day.

d. The average number of active *SCRAM Remote Breath Devices*.

The average number is between 10 and 15 at a time.

- Please also provide the current daily rate the County is paying for *SCRAM Remote Breath Devices*.

The County is paying \$8.00 per day.

e. The number of active GPS devices.

The average number is between 1 at a time.

- Please also provide the current daily rate the County is paying for active GPS devices.

The County is paying \$13.00 per day.

f. The number of passive GPS devices.

The average number is between 0 at a time.

- Please also provide the current daily rate the County is paying for passive GPS devices.

The County is paying \$10.00 per day.

g. The number of Standard House Arrest or radio frequency (RF) devices.

The average number is between 1 at a time.

- Please also provide the current daily rate the County is paying for Standard House Arrest or RF devices.

The County is paying \$10.00 per day.

6. Reference *RFP Section II—Conditions Governing the Procurement, Item 1*, page 2

- a. The current *Sequence of Events* allows for only two (2) business days between Sandoval County's (the County) response to written questions and the proposal due date. The industry standard for submission of proposal responses is to ship documents via overnight delivery two (2) business days prior to the due date. To allow offerors sufficient time to incorporate the County's answers to written questions and submit responses, we respectfully request that the deadline be extended to allow for at least two (2) weeks between the response to written questions and the proposal submittal due date and time.

By New Mexico Procurement Code 13-1-104, the least amount of time allowed by law is ten calendar days. More complex projects like construction would require more time.

7. Reference *RFP Section IV—Detailed Scope of Work, Item B.1*, page 12.

- a. "The Offeror shall provide the DWI Program with the following technology for Electronic Monitoring: a. SCRAM for Secure Continuous Remote Alcohol Monitoring (24/7 alcohol monitoring) b. SCRAMx for alcohol and curfew monitoring c. SCRAM Remote Breath is a portable hand held breathalyzer with facial recognition and GPS."
- b. *SCRAM*, *SCRAMx*, and *SCRAM Remote Breath* are electronic monitoring devices that are specific to one manufacturer of equipment. There are alternative devices from other manufacturers that provide the same or superior functionalities of the *SCRAM*, *SCRAMx*, and *SCRAM Remote Breath* devices. Please confirm that offerors may propose alternative electronic monitoring devices that provide all features required by the County.

Offerors may propose alternative electronic devices that provide all the features that are required by the County.

8. Reference *RFP Section V—Detailed Scope of Work, Item A.1*, page 11.

"Must have a local representative available one (1) day per week"

And

*RFP Section V—Detailed Scope of Work, Item A.8*, page 12.

"Shall be present at court hearings to provide testimony."

- a. Please confirm the court hearings are on the same day of the week the local representative is required to be available to perform equipment installations, removals, and maintenance.

The County cannot guarantee that court hearings will be held on a certain as hearings are scheduled by the Court.
