RESOLUTION NO. 8-9-18.6A

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") of Sandoval County, New Mexico (the "County"), has determined upon its own initiative to submit to a general election the questions of the issuance of its general obligation bonds in the maximum amount and for the purposes hereinafter specified without the prior filing of a petition by qualified electors; and

WHEREAS, the Board adopted Resolution No. 7-26-18.10 on July 26, 2018 calling for a general obligation bond election, and has since obtained further financial information such that the Board deems it necessary to repeal said resolution and adopt this resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board that it is necessary and in the best interests of the residents of the County that there be submitted to a vote of the registered qualified electors of the County, the questions of whether the County should issue its general obligation bonds for the purposes hereinafter specified; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SANDOVAL COUNTY, NEW MEXICO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Board, on its own initiative, does hereby call for the following questions to be on the ballot and submitted to the registered qualified electors of Sandoval County, New Mexico, at a general election to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018 (the "Election Date"):

"Shall Sandoval County be authorized to issue up to \$3,385,000 of general obligation bonds, to be paid from property taxes, for the purpose of purchasing library books and resources, including equipment, upgrades, and improvements for libraries?"

"Shall Sandoval County be authorized to issue up to \$5,200,000 of general obligation bonds, to be paid from property taxes, for the purpose of designing, engineering, acquiring and installing County public safety and government telecommunication systems equipment?"

"Shall Sandoval County be authorized to issue up to \$4,850,000 of general obligation bonds, to be paid from property taxes, for the purpose of designing, expanding, equipping, furnishing, and otherwise improving public safety projects?"

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 4-49-8, NMSA 1978 the Notice of Election shall be published in full, in substantially the following form with only such changes as are approved by the County Manager and the County Clerk and as provided by law, in English and Spanish once a week for at least three (3) consecutive weeks.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at a general election (the "Election") to be held in Sandoval County, New Mexico (the "County") on Tuesday, the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2018, there will be presented for vote to the qualified registered electors of the County the following questions:

"Shall Sandoval County be authorized to issue up to \$3,385,000 of general obligation bonds, to be paid from property taxes, for the purpose of purchasing library books and resources, including equipment, upgrades, and improvements for libraries?"

"Shall Sandoval County be authorized to issue up to \$5,200,000 of general obligation bonds, to be paid from property taxes, for the purpose of designing, engineering, acquiring and installing County public safety and government telecommunication systems equipment?"

"Shall Sandoval County be authorized to issue up to \$4,850,000 of general obligation bonds, to be paid from property taxes, for the purpose of designing, expanding, equipping, furnishing, and otherwise improving public safety projects?"

The general obligation bonds shall have a net effective interest rate of not more than ten percent (10%) a year, unless the State Board of Finance at any time prior to delivery of the bonds approves a higher net effective interest rate in writing, and the general obligation bonds shall mature not more than twenty (20) years from their date.

The polls, except the absentee precinct, for the Election will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on November 6, 2018. The polls shall be located within the County as follows:

EARLY VOTING SITES:

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, the Board of County Commissioners of Sandoval County, New Mexico, being the governing body of the County, has caused this notice to be published as required by law.

Section 3. The questions listed in Section 1 shall be submitted to all qualified registered County electors on a single ballot so that a tally can be maintained of the votes cast for and against the questions. Automatic voting machines shall be used.

Section 4. The ballot shall be printed in English and Spanish with plain clear type in black ink on white material of such size as will fit the machines. The ballot questions shall be in substantially the following form:

Section 5. The Chairman of the Board, the County Manager, and County Clerk of Sandoval County, New Mexico, be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this Resolution, including the giving of notice pursuant to Section 6-15-1, NMSA 1978, to the Local Government Division of the Department of Finance and Administration.

Section 6. The County Manager and the County Clerk are authorized and directed to take any and all steps necessary for the proper conduct of the election, including giving timely notice of the election by proclamation by publication and posting thereof and compliance with the Federal Voting Rights Act.

Section 7. All actions heretofore taken by the Board, the County Manager and the County Clerk not inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution be, and the same hereby are, ratified, approved and confirmed. Board Resolution No. 7-26-18.10 is hereby repealed.


