RESOLUTION NO. 8-9-18.6C

TO PLACE PROPERTY TAX LEVY QUESTION ON
THE NOVEMBER 6, 2018 GENERAL ELECTION
BALLOT FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPORTING
SANDOVAL REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Commission") of Sandoval County, New Mexico (the "County") is authorized under the Hospital Funding Act, Sections 4-48B-1 through 4-48B-29, NMSA 1978 (the "Act") to submit to the qualified electors of the County the question of imposing a mill levy to provide funds to support hospitals; and

WHEREAS, the Commission desires to submit the question of imposing a mill levy to the qualified electors of the County at the general election on November 6, 2018.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY OF SANDOVAL:

Section 1. The following question shall be placed on the ballot for the general election to be held on November 6, 2018:

"For the purpose of providing operating revenues for medical services including new substance abuse treatment and trauma care, and a return of behavioral health services, shall Sandoval County, New Mexico impose a mill levy of one and ninety hundredths (1.90) mills each year for eight (8) years on each dollar of net taxable value of property in Sandoval County, to pay to Sandoval Regional Medical Center in accordance with a health care facilities contract with Sandoval County?"

Section 2. The election upon the question set forth in Section 1 of this Resolution shall be called, held, conducted and canvassed in substantially the same manner as provided by law for the general election.




