NOTICE is hereby given that the Sandoval County Board of County Commissioners will meet on **Thursday December 12, 2019 at 6:00 P.M.** for the purpose of considering the adoption of legislative amendments to the Lodger's Tax Ordinance. The meeting to adopt proposed legislative amendments to the Lodgers' Tax Ordinance will take place in the **Commission Chambers at the Sandoval County Administration Bldg, 1500 Idalia Road Building D, Bernalillo, New Mexico, 87004.**

General Summary of the Proposed Lodgers' Tax Ordinance: The legislative amendments to the Lodgers' Tax Ordinance will be considered for adoption by the Board of County Commissioners pursuant to Section 6 of the Sandoval County Lodgers' Tax Ordinance. These amendments are summarized as follows:

A. Add definitions for "Short Term Rental Provider" and "Taxable Premises" in Section 36-96.

B. Remove exemption from Lodgers' Tax to persons offering fewer than three rooms for lodging in Section 36-100. Thus, Lodger's Tax will apply to all types of lodging, consistent with amendments to the State Lodger's Tax, §3-38-16, NMSA 1978.
