## RESOLUTION DIRECTING PUBLIC COMMENT FOR PROPOSED OIL AND GAS ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, both the Planning and Zoning Commission and the Board of County Commissioners seeks to have to the opportunity to have public comment memorialized in written form for review prior to completing a completed draft for final action;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Sandoval County, State of New Mexico, does hereby adopt a plan to receive written public comment during the entire period which is a proposed Oil and Gas Ordinance is being developed, drafted, and considered, and to receive live, oral public comment exclusively at the first public meeting which the Planning and Zoning Commission places such Oil and Gas Ordinance on its agenda for consideration of final action; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that County Board of Commissioners shall also receive and consider live, oral public comment exclusively at the first public meeting at which the County Board of Commissioners places such Oil and Gas Ordinance on its agenda for consideration of final action.
