Honorable Commissioners:

Regarding "Resolution No. 6-22-22.10 Calling on the New Mexico Legislature to enhance the faith of the voting public in election outcomes through improved election processes", please vote NO.

The first three paragraphs are correct, yet the rest of the Resolution undermines the meaning of those three sentences by encouraging the perception the election system is seriously flawed. Of course, no actual problems are cited as evidence for any of the "whereas" statements.

For example: "Prohibit the Use of Ballot Drop Boxes. Unattended ballot drop boxes – even those who [SIC] are electronically surveilled – pose an unacceptable risk to the election process by making illegal ballot harvesting easier and should be prohibited."

There is zero evidence to justify the "making illegal ballot harvesting easier," statement. To the contrary there is ample evidence from New Mexico and across the nation in even in the last round of elections that there are indeed no such problems. Prohibiting successful civic engagement by voters, and especially repeating unfounded fraud claims undermines faith in the democratic systems.

The Resolution itself undermines "faith in our election process [which] is the foundation upon which our democracy rests," when it repeats unfounded claims and would have everyone's votes in doubt because a tiny, but powerful minority voices unfounded doubts about the outcome ."

The Resolution itself is a huge irregularity deliberately designed to undermine the faith in our election process, and our democracy. Vote NO!
