

SANDOVAL COUNTY, NEW MEXICO **RESOLUTION NO. 7-15-21.11B**

ESTABLISHING FEES FOR SUBDIVISION AND PLATTING APPLICATIONS

WHEREAS, Sandoval County has in the past established fees for subdivision and platting applications; and

WHEREAS, the Sandoval County Board of County Commissioners recognizes that the existing fees no longer represent the governmental costs associated with processing such applications; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, the Governing Body of Sandoval County, New Mexico that the following fees are established for subdivision and platting applications:

Any person desiring to subdivide land in the County shall pay the following administrative fees:

Preliminary plat:

\$75.00/lot

Final plat:

\$25.00/lot

Summary review plat: \$125.00 plus \$10.00/lot

Variance:

\$200.00

Appeal:

Vacation:

\$200.00

Rancho Estates; \$200.00 all others

\$50.00 Vacations associated with Lot Consolidation in Rio

Claim of Exemption: \$50.00 Lot Consolidation in Rio Rancho Estates: \$150.00

Family Transfer: \$200.00 all others

Claim of Exemption/Vacation Combined: \$100.00 Lot Consolidation in Rio

Rancho Estates; \$250.00 all others

Engineering Fees: To cover engineering expenses related to reviewing subdivisions and subsequent construction under this Ordinance, an engineering fee equal to 105% of the actual costs to the County for engineering review shall be charged. This fee shall be paid in full prior to the recording of any final plat in the office of the County Clerk or the release of any required improvement guarantees that have been posted by the subdivider as a condition of plat approval.
