The *National Weather Service* announced today, Wednesday, April 19, 2023, that it is removing its Flood Advisory for the Jemez Corridor and that now a ***Special Weather Statement*** is in place for the region. While no flooding is anticipated at this time, the Special Weather Statement urges caution in the mountains.

Sandoval County Office of Emergency Management reminds all residents and visitors to the area not to go near the river or walk along the riverbanks. The water is still moving quickly, and it is cold and filled with debris.

Sandoval County Public Works asks that all travelers along Highway 4 be aware that road repairs are underway and to be mindful of construction and road crews and construction vehicles in the area. The shoulders of Highway 4 are closed and parking along the highway is not allowed.
