NOTE: ONCE THE APPROPRIATE CHECKLIST ITEMS ARE SUBMITTED, THEY MUST BE DEEMED COMPLETE BY STAFF PRIOR TO PROCESSING. THESE TYPES OF REVIEWS GENERALLY TAKE 7-10 DAYS. IF ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IS REQUIRED, THE APPLICANT WILL BE NOTIFIED DURING THAT TIME PERIOD.

ALL BUILDINGS WHICH REQUIRE A NM CID PERMIT MUST BE ADDRESSED PER NM CID REGULATIONS.

	Site Plan & Vicinity Map: <u>2 copies</u> - indicate areas of agriculture/ranching activity. If buildings or structures are included, indicate location(s) on site plan and indicate distances from location(s) to all property lines.
	Building Plans: if buildings or structures are included, provide 2 complete sets of plans for all buildings or structures.
	(<i>If applicable</i>) A copy of the approved Driveway Permit from the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) – required if accessing onto a State Highway (refer to NMDOT contact info on page 3)
	\$75.00 Review Fee & \$5.00 New Address Fee (if requested)
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*	After staff completes the zoning compliance, floodplain determination, and issuance of a new physical address (if applicable), the building permit application and plans must be taken to the New Mexico Construction Industries Division (CID) at 5500 San Antonio Drive NE in Albuquerque for review and issuance of the building permit. CID also performs inspections in Sandoval County's jurisdiction.
