If your property was damaged by the *Cerro Pelado Fire*, you may qualify for assistance from the **Emergency Watershed Protection Program (EWP Program)**, a recovery effort aimed at relieving imminent hazards to life and property caused by floods, fires, windstorms, and other natural disasters.

Please note that if your property was damaged by a different fire or natural disaster, you may still be eligible for funding with a 25% match requirement.
