Pursuant to Section 1-14-13.2, NMSA 1978 and 1.10.23.9 NMAC, the post-election voting system check is performed for each statewide election. A System Recheck of the 2023 Regular Local Election results for Sandoval County Precincts 122, 029, 128, 137, 091, 056, 066, 099 and 093 was held on December 5, 2023 and completed on December 8, 2023.

A second recheck of Precinct 66 for Early Voting and Absentee of the 2023 Regular Local Election will be conducted on Monday, December 18, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. at the Sandoval County Clerk/BOE Warehouse, located at 800 S. Hill Road, Bernalillo, NM 87004.

The County Clerk shall report their results to the auditor as soon as the counting team completes their task.

Consistent with Subsection H Section 1-14-13.2 NMSA 1978, county canvass observers may be present during the audit process and shall be subject to Section 1-2-31 NMSA 1978.

The County Clerk shall provide instructions to all observers, watchers of the public regarding any rules governing their conduct during an audit, voting systems check, recheck or recount. At all times during an audit process, those present to observe shall wear badges designating themselves as an authorized observer of the organization or candidate which they represent or as a member of the public.

Those present to observe shall not:

- (1) Wear an identification other than the badge described above;
- (2) Wear any party or candidate pins;
- (3) Perform any duty of the recount, recheck, or audit workers;
- (4) Handle any election material;
- (5) Interfere with the orderly conduct of workers conducting the process; or
- (6) Use cell phones, audio, or video tape equipment whole observing the process.
