



All non re-enrolled 4-H'ers will not be receiving email newsletters or updates as of March 2, 2025—Newsletter is always posted on website

No photocopies or cellphone photos of enrollment, medical releases, or registrations, etc. will be accepted. They are not legible to us.

October 1, 2024 to March 1, 2025 gives you 5 months to enroll!

*Projects that are not available online have a purchase and shipping cost that will be charged to you if we have to order from the State 4-H office.

To receive scholarships, or enter projects and/or exhibit livestock for County Fair, you must be in good 4-H standing, ie, fully enrolled, and you must have attended at least 40% of ALL club meetings, and participated in Fair Clean-Up Day. This includes Council Officer attendance at 4-H County Council meetings.

- 1. We must have your completed enrollment Medical Release online with zSuite/ and remember to <u>UPLOAD MEDICAL RELEASE</u> in zSuite, or email to sandoval@nmsu.edu NO PHOTO COPIES!
- 2. Choose ALL your projects! Recommended a Maximum of 5. For Livestock, choose EACH one to be included for tagging and to be eligible to exhibit/show in the Sandoval County Fair.
- 3. No additional projects can be selected after March 1. Choose Arts & Crafts if you are doing those individually or at your club meetings.
- 4. Projects that are not available online, you will be notified of the cost.

Both Adults/Leaders and Youth will not be approved for the 4-H Enrollment until you have completed the following:

Medical Release that has a <u>physical signature</u> uploaded into zSuite system. If you are having trouble, download the medical release, scan and email to sandoval@nmsu.edu.

Adults/Leaders—Medical Release and you must be screened (Fee is \$10 every 5 years—Cost \$10) and completed Working with Minors module EVERY YEAR located in the Left Bar under the tab Clover Academy in zSuite. Once there, click on "Launch Clover Academy" which is the Working With Minors. Click on the "Working with Minors" course then a blue button will appear that says "Reset all Course Progress for New Year." Upon completion, you will get a certificate at the end of the quiz. Email certificate to sandoval@nmsu.edu as proof. If you did not receive an approved enrollment email, something is missing. All enrollments will remain pending in zSuites until Medical Release Forms received and if applicable, Working with Minors.



Scholarship Information

A Scholarship fund has been established by the 4-H County Council to provide financial assistance to 4-H members that wish to attend State, District, or County 4-H events. Scholarship will cover 50% of the registration expenses for Senior Leadership Retreat, Youth-Get-Away, Livestock School, Horse School, FCS School, 4-H Dog School, or \$250 of the team fees for serving as a State 4-H Officer, Ambassador, or a Diplomat. The scholarship will cover 100% of the registration expenses for 4-H County Camp.

The funding may not be used to attend State 4-H Conference, State 4-H Shooting Sports Contest, nor District Contest.

Scholarship Criteria—Available to any Novice, Junior or Senior 4-H Member.

State 4-H Office Community Service & Scholarship Information

If a youth is interested in attending one of the annual events and are looking for a way to assist with registration costs they can apply for the New Mexico 4-H Community Service Scholarship. The scholarship will cover the registration expenses for Senior Leadership Retreat, Youth Get-Away, Livestock School, Horse School, State 4-H Conference, 4-H International Exchange, FCS School, 4-H Dog School or \$250 of the team fees for serving as a State 4-H Officer or Ambassador.

The applicant can create their own community service or if they would like to work with an organization in creating a new program that is acceptable. The project must be an activity that the youth designs, organizes and implements that will have an impact on the community. Scholarship Applications for the events are due two months before the event registration deadline. Forms must be filled out online when submitting applications. The application is approved or declined by a committee. If declined, the applicant will be asked to provide further information on the proposal.

If the applicant submitted a scholarship application for an event and received the scholarship, they need to have their community service report complete and submitted to the State 4-H Office before they can apply for the community service scholarship for any future events.
