Important Times

Office Hours: 8 AM – 5 PM Filing Hours: 9 AM – 5 PM*

* There will be NO filings processed prior to 9 AM and NO filings accepted after 5 PM. It is your responsibility to arrive with adequate time to fully complete the filing process between 9 AM and 5 PM.

General Reminders

- Prior to coming in to file, remove all staples, paper clips, post-it notes, or any other foreign material from your petition pages. Failure to do so will result in increased processing times and potentially obscured signatures.
- Know your Voter ID: Check the "Find My Registration and Election Information" section of nmvote.org to find your Voter ID. Having this available will help BOE staff quickly and accurately add you to your contest.
- Be prepared: Review 2025 Regular Local Election Candidate Information
 Maggie Toulouse Oliver New Mexico Secretary of State (nm.gov) to
 ensure you have all required forms

Important Document Reminders:

Declaration of Candidacy

Review your voter record at nmvote.org and compare it to the information on your Declaration of Candidacy; the information on your Declaration must be identical to your voter registration, pay special attention to the following areas:

- Name
- Address
- > Date of Birth
- > Party of Registration

Changes to registration must have been made on or before August 6, 2025 pursuant to 1-10-6(A) NMSA 1978.

Declaration of Candidacy must be notarized.

Nominatina Petitions

Prior to coming in to file, remove all staples, paper clips, post-it notes, or any other foreign material from your petition pages. Failure to do so will result in increased processing times and potentially obscured signatures.

<u>Affidavit of Designation (if applicable)</u>

If you will be designating an individual to file on your behalf, they must bring with them an Affidavit of Designation.

Reminder: The designee will NOT be able to make any changes on behalf of the candidate.

Confidential Public Address Request

- If you wish to make your address confidential upon filing, please bring this form with you.
- Should you be qualified, you will remain eligible to have your address designated as confidential until the election.
 - If you win your election, your address will remain confidential for 2 years.
 - If you lose your election, your confidential address designation will be removed.
- If you are disqualified, your confidential address designation will be removed.

SCHOOL DISTRICT REPORTING ACT

Pursuant to Article 22A (School District Campaign Reporting Act) of New Mexico Election Law, certain offices are covered within the act that are required to create an online campaign reporting login at https://login.cfis.sos.state.nm.us/.

These covered offices that are required to report are: a position of board of education member of a school district, or the position of board member of a community college organized or operating pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 21, Article 13 or Article 16 of New Mexico state law. All candidates will need to create an account whether they receive campaign contributions or make campaign expenditures or choose not to. Any candidate who does not raise money or spend money will need to file a report of no activity for each reporting period.
