1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Juarez called meeting to order at 5:00p.m. Present were Chair Juarez, Vice Chair Herr, Commissioner Bruch and Commissioner Jones.

2. CONCLUDE CANVASS OF RESULTS OF THE 2026 MUNICIPAL RUN-OFF ELECTION RESULTS FOR THE CITY OF RIO RANCHO.

It was reported that, following the April 14, 2026 election, no candidate among the six candidates received fifty percent of the vote, resulting in a runoff election between Paul Wymer and Alexandra Pilland.

Paul Wymer received the majority of the votes, and was therefore declared the winner. It was noted that, pending approval, he will be sworn in at the end of the month.

Commissioner Bruch asked about the language on page 1 as it was incorrect. Commissioner Jones asked if they were able to approve the Canvas due to the error. County Manager, Wayne Johnson specified that a motion to approve with the change in language on page 1 may be changed from "of the eligible Sandoval county voters to eligible Rio Rancho registered voters".

Commissioner Jones made a motion to correct the language, seconded by Vice Chair Herr. Commissioner Bruch, Commissioner Jones, Chair Juarez, and Vice Chair Herr. Motion passed unanimously.

3. ADJOURN

Vice Chair Herr made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Jones to adjourn at 5:04pm.


